- 1) All students must travel to and from school in uniform.
- 2) The crested school jacket must be worn by students traveling daily to and from school.
- 3) The crested school jacket must be worn on any off-campus school trip or event as it forms part of our risk assessment. No other jacket is permissible, and students will be unable to travel without it.
- 4) Formal school uniform or school tracksuits must be worn when travelling to and from matches.
- 5) Boarding students may wear casual dress to tea and prep adhering to the code outlined further on.
- 6) Students may wear neat casual clothes on Saturday and Sunday (see below) except for special Chapel services, where full uniform is required.

EVENING UNIFORM

Uniform rules for students from tea-time to bedtime

Students can wear their school uniform, or they can wear the following appropriate casual uniform. This is a privilege, if the Uniform Code is breached by a student during teatime and bedtime, then the student involved will revert to the full school uniform for a period of time.

Hoodies, sweatshirts, sweaters.

Loose t-shirt of their choice.

Plain jeans, casual pants, or plain tracksuit bottoms.
